5856 TO RECEIVE A REPORT FROM THE POLICE AND THE LOCAL WARD COUNCILLOR.

5857 TO AGREE THE ORDER OF THE AGENDA.

5858 TO APPROVE THE MINUTES OF THE PARISH COUNCIL MEETINGS HELD ON THE 17TH DECEMBER 2024. CHAIRMAN TO SIGN AND INITIAL EACH PAGE.

It was noted that the date on the header of the minutes was incorrect. This was amended and the minutes of the meeting held on the 17th December 2024 were **approved**, taken as read and signed & initialled by the Chairman as a true and accurate record.

5859 TO **NOTE** MISCELLANEOUS REPORTS/UPDATES FROM MEMBERS/CLERK - **FOR INFORMATION ONLY**:

- Litter-Cross Street, Willerby & Grange Park Lane – reported to ERYC Street scene. The Parish Clerk informed the Parish Council that after being informed by a resident, several areas of litter in the area had been reported to ERYC.
- Parking, Main Street, Willerby – The Parish Clerk informed the Parish Council that a resident had reported concerns regarding inconsiderate parking on Main Street, Willerby (leading up to the Crematorium). The Parish Clerk confirmed that this issue had been reported to ERYC Traffic Management, and that they have agreed to mark out several advisory parking bays which they believe will alleviate the problem.
- Xmas tree lights 2025 – Lite Ltd reported that on removal of Christmas tree lights it was noted that the power and connections were damaged. Parish Clerk to arrange for Lite Ltd to provide and install new lights on the Christmas Tree in 2025.

5860 TO CONSIDER/APPROVE THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF A NEW LITTER BIN ON WILLERBY LOW ROAD - SUBJECT TO SITE SURVEY BY ERYC.

Approved – The Parish Council considered the quotation for the purchase and installation of a litter bin on Willerby Low Road and **resolved to accept** the quotation of £364.99 (purchase) and £125.00 (installation) from ERYC. It was noted that this is subject to a site survey by ERYC and an area near to the traffic bollards was proposed by Cllr M Killeen. Parish Clerk to contact ERYC.

5861 PARISH CLERK TO INFORM PARISH COUNCIL OF CHANGES TO NATWEST BUSINESS BANKING CHARGES AS FROM 1ST MARCH 2025.

The Parish Clerk informed the Parish Council that due to changes in banking legislation; Town & Parish Councils were no longer subject to free business banking due to them being a form of government. Therefore, as from March 2025 both Parish Council NatWest accounts will be subject to NatWest's standard chargeable tariff. To minimise fees, it was agreed that as from 1st April 2025 monthly payments should be made online were possible.

5862 TO DISCUSS AND RESOLVE TO APPROVE COMMENTS AND/OR SUPPORT FOR THE FOLLOWING ERYC PROPOSALS:

- No waiting at any time restrictions and no loading at any time on Bessie Avenue, Great Gutter Lane West.

The Parish Council discussed the proposal and resolved to agree to submit the below comment:

- **The Parish Council has concerns with regards to the “no waiting and no loading at any time restrictions” and would like to request further information as to why these restrictions are being proposed.**

- No waiting at any time restrictions along a section of Well Lane to assist in easing congestion at school times, Cricket match days and allow residents to enter and exit their property safely.

The Parish Council discussed the proposal and resolved to agree to submit the below comment:

- **The Parish Council has concerns with regards to the “no waiting at any time restrictions” and would like to request further information as to why these restrictions are being proposed. The Parish Council has concerns as to the impact these restrictions may have on residents in the areas bordering the proposed sections of Well Lane. As the restrictions are being proposed to ease congestion at school times and on cricket match days, the Parish Council would like to enquire whether the possibility of the restrictions being time specific has been considered.**

The Parish Clerk informed the Parish Council that ERYC had confirmed that at this stage, this is an informal consultation between the Parish Council, Ward Councillors and ERYC highways department, and that it will go out to public consultation in the future. Parish Clerk to submit comments to ERYC by 31st January 2025.

5863 TO RECEIVE A REPORT ON THE YOUNG CHILDREN'S PLAYGROUND.

Cllr L Telford provided the Parish Council with a report on the playpark and confirmed that there were no outstanding equipment safety issues. It was noted that the area that had previously had graffiti removed may need further cosmetic work. Parish Clerk to contact Community Groundman to discuss. The Parish Clerk informed that Parish Council that metal bonding glue had been purchased for the community groundsman to repair an area on the small slide.
